



Clinical Doctoral Research Fellowships

“Obtain a PhD by research whilst still developing clinical skills”

This fellowship scheme is designed for graduates with some research experience who aspire to a career that combines research with continued clinical practice.

A Clinical Doctoral Research Fellowship funds:

- the salary costs of the award holder;
- PhD tuition fees;
- an appropriate research project;
- an overseas research visit;
- conference attendance;
- a tailored training and development programme.

Fellowships can be undertaken full time over three years, or part time over either four or five years. Applicants must have at least one year's experience of practice since graduating and hold current registration with the relevant professional council at the point of award.
