



Clinical Lectureships

Combine post-doctoral research
in an academic position with
continued clinical practice

This lectureship scheme is designed for early post-doctoral professionals wishing to develop into independent clinical academic researchers.

Award holders are supported to divide their time equally between their clinical and academic activities.

A Clinical Lectureship funds:

- 50% of the award holder's salary;
- the award holder's research;
- an overseas research visit;
- conference attendance;
- a tailored training and development programme.

Clinical Lectureships can be undertaken full time over three years or part time over either four or five years. Applicants must have at least one year's experience of post-graduate practice and hold current registration with the relevant professional council at the point of award.
