



Senior Clinical Lectureships

Combine research and research leadership in a senior academic position with continued clinical practice

This senior lectureship scheme is designed to facilitate the development of post-doctoral practicing clinicians with independent clinical research experience into clinical academic research leaders.

Award holders are supported to divide their time equally between their clinical and academic activities.

A Senior Clinical Lectureship is a five year award and funds:

- 50% of the award holder's salary;
- the award holder's research;
- an overseas research visit;
- conference attendance;
- a tailored training and development programme.

Applicants must have at least five year's experience of practice since graduating and hold current registration with the relevant professional council at the point of award.
